We are a rehabilitation facility for long-term therapy for alcoholic men with 67 beds. Our integrated therapy program includes medical care and treatment, psychotherapy with individual and group discussions as well as occupational therapy, sports therapy and physiotherapeutic applications as focal points.

Mr. Neumann has been with us in the nursing service since April 1st, 1991 in shift work. The nursing service is responsible for taking care of the patients intercurrent illnesses, the implementation of medical prescriptions such as changing bandages, circulatory checks, monitoring the dispensing of medication, etc. Monitoring compliance with the house rules is another task of the nursing service. In addition, there are organizational tasks such as organization of consultation hours, organization of external doctor visits, planning the room allocation and others.

The employees of the nursing service therefore have a responsible position in our house, because on the one hand they have control functions, on the other hand, especially in the evening hours they are the only present contact persons for the patients in the hospital. The task therefore requires a certain level of intuition in dealing with patients, some of whom have very different personality disorders.

Mr. Neumann quickly familiarized himself with the various areas of activity. When dealing with patients, he was empathetic and friendly and showed good observational skills. He completed the tasks assigned to him to our complete satisfaction.

Mr. Neumann is leaving us on December 31, 1992 for personal reasons. With Mr. Neumann we are losing a reliable and conscientious employee. We wish him all the best for his future.

REFERENCE

Mr. Gerhard N e u m a n n, born on September 14, 1961, was employed as a nurse in our specialist hospital from October 1, 1985 to February 29, 1988. During this time he worked exclusively in one of our acute psychiatric admission wards.

Langenberg Hospital is a community-based specialist hospital for addicts. Men and women from the surrounding regions who are addicted to alcohol and medication are treated and advised here on an outpatient and inpatient basis. The work of the ward teams is based on the principles of a therapeutic community, i. H. , as far as possible, the patients are involved in everyday hospital life. Patients are encouraged and supported in the area of personal responsibility and in making decisions as well as in acquiring social skills. In group and individual discussions, they are encouraged to think about further treatment steps. The nursing service, like all other professional groups, is involved in the process of group and individual work. The facility currently has 91 beds. Of these, 42 beds are in the acute-clinical psychiatric area. Here the patients receive besides their physical detoxification, information about their illness.

There are 49 beds in the long-term and therapy area. These are a psychotherapeutic ward and a ward with severely damaged, chronic patients.

These areas are socio-therapeutic rehabilitation facilities. The group work is in the foreground here; these are in particular: small psychotherapeutic groups, pedagogical role play, topic-centred discussion groups, relaxation training, movement therapy, work and occupational therapy, ward talks and a large number of leisure activities inside and outside the clinic. The nursing group has a significant part in the therapeutic process in all departments.

The area of responsibility of the nursing service on all wards includes not only the usual nursing measures for medical-somatic treatment, but also the organization of the wards and, in particular, the area of milieu therapy. These are the daily living requirements and needs of the patients such as eating, sleeping, hygiene, exercise and communication. This includes leading the daily ward meeting, in which patients and the nursing team discuss being together on the ward and the resulting conflicts and work out possible solutions in the spirit of social learning. Furthermore, this includes the specific support and guidance of individual patients who take on tasks within the framework of the ward organization, e.g. kitchen service and house cleaning. The area of responsibility of the nursing service also includes the organization of group activities, e.g. walking, baking, excursions and other leisure activities inside and outside the ward. An essential part of the work of the nursing service is the constant informal contact with the individual patients in the sense of a protective, supportive and accompanying function. Within this framework, an employee of the nursing service always takes part in the information groups and the medication discussions. In addition to the tasks already described, his duties also include participating in the daily team meetings and all other advisory and discussion bodies that take place in the hospital. This also includes participation in the monthly team supervisions.

Mr. Neumann had well-founded knowledge in the field of general nursing and was able to familiarize himself with the care and support of addicts. In psychiatric crisis situations, which often occur in an acute psychiatric admission ward, Mr. Neumann is safe.

When dealing with patients, Mr. Neumann was approachable and caring and was also able to bring patients' problems into the team. He was also able to establish the necessary closeness to the patient, which is important when working with the mentally ill. Overall, Mr. Neumann had a good overview of the entire organization of the ward, which was particularly noticeable during his night shifts. During his work in our company he was punctual, reliable and honest. He was always polite and correct towards his superiors.
